

## GERING VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT

## **2019 Annual Report**

The Gering Volunteer Fire Department is committed to protecting the people

and property of our community from hazards and emergencies through education, risk reduction and emergency response. 2019 has been a busy meeting our objective and the needs of the community.

This past year the department migrated to a new reporting system. The massive undertaking takes us into mobile data and allows firefighters to actively participate in their training. We implemented several mobile data terminals to compliment the new county dispatch system and offer data in the field to better respond. Real time mapping, fire pre plans, in field electronic PCR and access data anywhere assists us with responding to emergencies and collecting accurate information.

This year we have documented over 6,200 man hours of training and activities. 7 members obtained Firefighter II certification. 3 members attended and working towards EMT certification. 3 members became credentialed as All Hazard Planning Section Chef. Firefighters also attended leadership training, Engine Boss Qualification class, Firefighter 1 and attend weekly drills on various trainings. The Fire Department also hosted the largely anticipated interagency Engine Academy. This year over 200 people from across the central states attended the 3 day exercise.

Firefighters from Gering spent 10 days in Santa Rosa California assigned to a large wildfire. This was the first assignment after the lengthy process of obtaining a contract with the Nebraska Forest Service.

Ashley Maschmeier became the first female to receive the Fire Department's "LeRoy Elliott" Firefighter of the Year. Jim Lawson was elected as Secretary-Treasurer of the Scotts Bluff County Mutual Aid. Darrell Vance was elected as the 2nd Vice President of the Nebraska State Volunteer Firefighters Association (the 7th firefighter from Gering to hold this office).

This is the 19th year of the Mutual Finance Assistance Fund from the state of Nebraska. The city received \$45,421 and the Rural received \$22,264. The department also received 3 grants totaling \$7,900 to be used towards PPE, training and replacement of fire prevention equipment.

## **6TH STREET FIRE**

On February 25th at 2:21 Gering Fire was dispatched to a multifamily dwelling with 6 apartments. Arrived to find fire engulfing the back portion of the structure. Firefighters engaged the fire and minimized fire spread to the semaining apartments. In total, 3 apartments were directly affected by flames. It is estimated 12-15 residents were displaced by the fire and received assistance through Firefighter Ministries.

22 firefighters spent several hours battling the blaze and received automatic aid from Scottsbluff with 10 firefighters,

## YEARLY INCIDENT STATISTICS

2019 seen 709 calls for service, an increase from last year by 136 and. This year we had several large weather events that added to our response. 535 calls were deemed as Rescue or EMS calls. These include medical and trauma response, technical rescue or search and motor vehicle accidents.

81 calls, or 12%, overlapped. Multiple apparatus responded during the same time period to manage multiple incidents. Our average response for all types of call is approximately 7 1/2 minutes, which is 98% compliant against an 8 minute response value.

We spent an average of 43 minutes on all emergencies. Our full manpower is usually on scene of a fire for multiple hours. EMS calls tend to see an average of 20 minutes on scene. This year 76 calls were in our rural district and we provided mutual aid 20 times to are fire departments.

Our busiest times is on Thursday at 9:00 am and Wednesday at 5:00 pm. Thursday was our busiest day followed by Saturday and July was our busiest month, which is typical through the past 10 years.

We had two residential fires that seen heavy loss. Property involved in fire amounts to \$1,386,514. We had an estimated \$308,400 loss from fire and saved an estimated \$1,078,114.

## MONTHLY DRILLS

GERING AND SCOTTSBLUFF FIRE DEPARTMENTS PARTICIPATE IN MONTHLY TRAININGS. THE PURPOSE OF THE TRAINING IS FIRE-FIGHTER SURVIVAL AND RAPID INTERVENTION IN THE EVENT A FIRE-FIGHTER BECOMES HURT DURING AN INCIDENT. EVERY OTHER MONTH EACH DEPARTMENT HOSTS THE OTHER AND HONES IN ON RESCUE SKILLS.

OUR MONTHLY DRILLS HAS MORPHED INTO VARIOUS OTHER TRAININGS, INCLUDING LIVE FIRES, VENTILATIONS, ROPE RESCUE AND DIVE RESCUE. OUR DEPARTMENT DEDICATES ROUGHLY 36 HOURS OF RAPID INTERVENTION TRAINING EACH YEAR TO MEET THE NFPA STANDARDS PERTAINING TO A RAPID INTERVENTION TEAM.



Gering Fire Department logged 5,561 man-hours of training in 2019. Training occurs at a minimum once a week and more often 5 times per month. Majority of our training is dedicated to firefighter and EMS training.

This year we sent 4 firefighters through an EMT course. They are currently in the testing process to become a certified Nebraska EMT. This course is approximately 200 hours long and incorporates many hours in the field implementing skills.

8 firefighters attended a 36 hour course to become certified as a Firefighter Type 2. This certification teaches fire behavior and safety in the wildland environment. Firefighters learned pump operation, safety, proper PPE and spent a day in the field on a live fire exercise.

We continue to be current and compliant with NIMS training. Officers have completed the required courses and new firefighters are complete FEMA's required courses.

This is our 2nd year hosting the West Nebraska Engine Academy. This 3 day exercise brings approximately 100 firefighters across the region

to Gering. It is an interagency exercise and is intended to develop our firefighters and increase their training. This exercise is not held anywhere else in the state and our firefighters dedicate multiple days in preparation.

# LEROY ELLIOTT FIREFIGHTER OF THE YEAR

Leroy Elliott was a firefighter for Gering Fire Department for almost 50 years. Every year he was one of the top responders, even when he was in his 70's. Leroy represented what it meant to be a top firefighter.

In 2019 Ashley was awarded this award. She accumulated over 275 hours of training and activities and responded to 370 calls. She joined our department in 2018 after a year in our newly created Cadet Program. She has obtained her EMT license and FF2.

### PERSONNEL STATISTICS

People are our number one asset in any organization. Gering Fire supports our firefighters and invests in their career at the department. In 2019 we logged over 4,357 man-hours of training and 1,921 in public service. Because our staff is invaluable, we could never put a cost savings number on our response.

Our roster includes 39 firefighters, with 2 currently in their probationary phase. Our average age is 40 years old and we have seen a large increase in members that are between 20-30 years of age.

As mentioned previously, Ashley Maschmeier received the Firefighter of the Year Award. Darrell Vance holds 2nd Vice President of the Nebraska State Volunteer Firefighters Association. Jake Pittman and Charlie Gannon received their 5 years of service award. Jamy Lawson has served the citizens of Gering for 25 years and received a 25 year award.

30 out of 39 members qualified for the City of Gering Incentive Program and expected to increase in the coming years.

We currently have 5 cadets in the Gering Fire Department Cadet Program. We will create some publications to share with the Gering High School to promote the program in hopes to see additional cadets.

### FM GLOBAL GRANT

In 2019 Gering Fire requested a grant to replace Smokey Bear. Smokey was over 12 years old and has seen better days.

Gering Fire applied for a grant to FM Global. FM Global is an insurance company that has awarded thousands of grant to support fire prevention programs.

FM Global awarded Gering Fire \$3,079 to replace Smokey Bear. Gering Fire is the only department in the mutual aid that has been approved by the US Forest Service to own a Smokey Bear costume. However, Smokey Bear will always be available to departments in the mutual aid to promote fire prevention.

### FIRE PREVENTION

In 2019 Gering Fire reached an estimated 4,194 people promoting fire safety and fire prevention. Through our multiple programs we have delivered fire prevention material and gave presentations. On several occasions we have given free smoke detectors to families in need.

Our fire prevention material is paid for through donations from local businesses. National Fire Safety Council develops a program that solicits local businesses. We partner with Scottsbluff Fire Department and have been extremely successful with this program. In 2019 local businesses raised \$8,308 to fund all material.

Every year the mutual aid participate in Kidz Explorer. Gering Fire takes a 2 hour time slot and hands out pamphlets to over 350 people. Kids receive coloring books, wrist bands and fire helmets. It has been a great opportunity to reach kids and play fire prevention games.

We had 32 5th grade students participate in our Junior Fire Patrol program. This long lasting program teach 5th graders about home escape plans, fire safety and first aid. Kids visit the fire station once a night for 6 weeks. The last night we hand out awards for our top performing students. This program has been a huge success and we consider this to a top program in the state.
