2021 Annual Report

The Gering Volunteer Fire Department is committed to protecting the people and property of our community from hazards and emergencies through education, risk reduction and emergency response. The fire department met each challenge head on and was able to exceed performance expectations.

2021 brought the busiest year the department has seen. Between many extended trainings, large fire response and back-to-school fire prevention, we logged over 23,000 man hours. Department partnered with many agencies to assist with vaccination clinics, community events and special response within the county.

7 members obtained their Firefighter 1 certificate after a 6 month national course. 6 members obtained their Hazardous Material Operation certificate after a 3 month course. Members also attended fire school, a week long fire calculation course, dive certification and technical rescue. Firefighters had a total of 5,158 man-hours of training.

9 firefighters spent a total of 21 days in Montana on a large fire. This hard work is because of a contract with the Nebraska Forest Service. Gering FD is the only department in Nebraska that has this type of contract and our governing boards see revenue associated with these assignments.

Gering FD supported community events throughout the year. Firefighters assisted with Old West Balloon Fest, Laser Light Show, Oregon Trail Days and drive thru vaccination clinics.

With the support from council, Gering FD added a new position to the fire department. This reduces time spent away from employers during the daytime. This position has been critical with administrative duties, vehicle maintenance and relief for our firefighters during daytime response.

Tim Milton received the Fire Department's "LeRoy Elliott" Firefighter of the Year. Jim Lawson recognized for 50 years of dedicated service. He joins only 2 other people that has committed over 50 years to the department.



On behalf of the Fire Department, I would like to thank Mayor Kaufman and the council for heir continued support and cooperation given to us throughout the year.



2021 WILDFIRES

Due to persistent drought conditions through the summer, Gering FD seen 4 large wildfires in August through November. Hackberry Fire, Cross Fire, Vista Trend Fire and the Buffalo Creek Fire were large extended events.

Gering FD personnel spent many days and nights suppressing these fire. Several of our firefighters played pivotal roles in managing these fires.

The community supported all fire departments with donations of non perishables and water. We wish to thank the entire community for their continued support of the firefighters.

YEARLY INCIDENT STATISTICS


2021 seen 796 calls for service, which is in line with the previous year. 75% of call volume accounted for medical and vehicle accidents. Fires have been consistent with previous years with the exception of large wildland fires. Our firefighters spent multiple days in a row on 4 large wildfires that consumed more than 26,000 acres.

19%, or 151 calls overlapped. Multiple apparatus responded during the same time period to manage multiple incidents. Overlapping events are worrisome for our staffing model, and overlap has been increasing over the years.

Our average response for all types of calls within the city limits was just over 5 minutes. Average turn out time (dispatched to enroute) for all types of calls within the city limits was 2 minutes 53 seconds.

We spent an average of 176 minutes on scene of all emergencies, largely in part to several prolonged events. EMS calls tend to see an average of 25 minutes on scene. We provided mutual aid 40 times to area fire departments.

Our busiest times is on Thursday at 6:00 pm. Our busiest hour was between 10:00 am and 11:00 am. The busiest day is on a Monday. January was our busiest month with 80 total calls.

Firefighter 1 Certificate

The Firefighter 1 certification process takes about 9 months. Firefighters must obtain 2 certifications at once in order to meet the minimum benchmark.

Firefighter 1 has a direct affect on our ISO rating. Because Firefighter 1 is the NFPA minimum standard, ISO looks at how many firefighters are certified to this level. Currently we have over 30 firefighters at this level.


Firefighter 1 also assists when we apply for grant funding. Many federal grants require compliance to a minimum standard. Working towards 100% compliance is beneficial for grant opportunities.

TRAINING STATISTICS

Gering Fire Department logged 5,158 man-hours of training in 2021. Training occurs at a minimum of once a week and more often 5 times per month. Majority of our training is dedicated to firefighting and EMS in order to achieve proper ISO ratings.

We had several extended courses this year. 7 firefighters enrolled in the Firefighter 1, which is a national certification course. This course was a blended learning and took 9 months. 4 firefighters attended a week long fire calculations course to obtain their S390 certificate. 4 firefighters attended a 24 hour wildland course to obtain the Firefighter II minimum certificate. We sent many firefighters to conferences out of town for several days at a time.

This is our 4rd year hosting the Nebraska Engine Academy. The 3 day exercise brought over 200 firefighters to Gering to participate and learn how to manage a large scale emergency. Many of our firefighters scrve on the Nebraska State Type 3 Response Team formed by the Governor in 2021. Because of our commitment to managing emergencies, these firefighters play a critical role to bring emergencies to a successful end. Because of the Academy we have built relationships statewide and are seen as one of the most progressive departments in the state.

PERSONNEL STATISTICS

People are our number one asset in any organization. Gering Fire Department supports our firefighters and invests in their career at the department. In 2021 we logged over 7,912 man hours of regional, state and local trainings and meetings. Because our staff is invaluable, we could never put a cost savings number on our response.

Our roster includes 42 firefighters and 2 Cadets. Our Department implemented a Cadet Program that introduces high school seniors to the fire service. We also partnered with Gering PD and Gering High School to implement an Public Safety Academy for high school students . 6 students spend at least 1.5 hours per day at the fire station, assisting and learning about emergency response.

This past year we recognized Jim Lawson for 50 years of service to Gering residents. Jim has been an Assistant Chief, President and has served on many state committees. He continues to teach young fire-fighters at Nebraska State Fire School and develops our young firefighters. We congratulate Jim on serving for 50 years. Jim joins two other firefighters that has served for 50 years.



FIRE PUP PROGRAM

Gering Fire teams up with Scottsbluff Fire and the National Fire Safety Council to fund fire prevention material. We have participated in this program for over 20 years.

NFSC manages the program and solicits local businesses to assist in making fire prevention supplies like coloring books, helmets and booklets.

Local businesses donate an average of \$8,000 each year to fund much needed supplies. Both fire departments utilize these supplies throughout the year.

This program saves each city thousands a year. We couldn't do it without local support.

FIRE PREVENTION AND PUBLIC RELATIONS

Gering FD captured 1,704 man hours of fire prevention and education. We were able to offer our Junior Fire Patrol program to 5th grade students after a brief hiatus due to COVID policies. We had 26 5th grade students spend 6 nights at the fire station. It was another success.

Last October we worked with schools and followed guidelines to enter and present education programs. We came in contact with an estimated 250 kids and taught various ways to prevent fire.

Our fire prevention material is paid for through donations from local businesses. National Fire Safety Council develops a program that solicits local businesses. We partner with Scottsbluff Fire Department and have been extremely successful with this program. In 2021 local Gering businesses raised \$4,535 to fund all material.

We assisted the Oregon Trail Days Committee with compliance checks through the Food Fair. Through prevention, we assisted 20 different vendors with creating a compliant and safe working environment. This further reduced potential for injuries and fires.

On the last day of school we took over equipment and allowed junior high students to participate with operating equipment. The students had a blast running through a large foam blanket.






