There were a few new requests from Oregon Trail Days and a new request for the Gravel Nationals (bike race). Empowering Families hasn't made a request for a few years but came back this year.

City Engineer, Annie Folck, stated that Westwood Estates is located near Five Rocks Road (she showed the location on the general location map on the screen). 20th Street is currently stubbed in on the south and north. A preliminary and final plat were submitted. As part of that, there are some improvements that need to be made. The street is not existing in this area where it is platted as part of the new right of way. There also needs to be a water line; it's currently stubbed in on the south and north but it needs to be connected which will actually eliminate a couple of dead ends. In addition, the lots on the east already have existing sewer in the alleyway, but the lots on the west need to have the sewer line extended as well. Planning Commission did recommend approval of the preliminary and final plat, but it was conditional upon passing a development agreement. This is standard procedure whenever a subdivision goes in, just to make sure that if things don't go according to plan, and they don't put in all of the improvements right away, someone doesn't come back years later and expect the City to pay for all of those improvements. The development agreement makes it clear that the property owner is responsible for all of those costs and not the City. Staff recommends approval of the agreement and legal has reviewed it as well.

The tournament is held on President's Day weekend Friday through Sunday (shoulder season business), and provides substantial economic impact by boosting hotel stays in Gering and the area as well as restaurants. And utilizes multiple gymnasiums in Gering, Scottsbluff, Terrytown and Mitchell. Occ Tax Funds will be used to offset tournament costs for gym rentals, referees, t-shirts and awards. The Occ Tax Grant Review Committee (Gering Visitors Bureau Board of Directors) recommends funding the Scottsbluff-Gering Noon Lions Club in the amount of \$9,900.00 for the 2025 Annual Basketball Tournament. Funds to be used for gym rentals, referees, t-shirts and awards.

Participant and volunteer t-shirts will show Gering-Scottsbluff as the location for the event along with the 2024 commemorative logo. The Occ Tax Grant Review Committee (Gering Visitors Bureau Board of Directors) recommends funding to the WNCC Foundation-2024 Monument Marathon in the amount of \$6,800.00 for participant and volunteer commemorative t-shirts. Shirts will bear the City of Gering logo as a major sponsor.

2024 MODIFICATION/AMENDMENT OF 2017 & 2020 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE AGREEMENTS GERING HOSPITALITY GROUP, LLC

This Modification/Amendment of Economic Development Assistance Agreements related to the Gering Hospitality Group, LLC II is made and entered into by and between the City of Gering ("City"), and the Gering Hospitality Group, LLC (the "Applicant"). This Modification/Amendment Agreement applies to Economic Development Assistance Agreements between the City and Applicant dated June 15, 2017 & June 22, 2020.

All documents of the Economic Development Assistance Agreement entered by the parties on or about June 15, 2017, are attached hereto as Exhibit "A". All documents of the Economic Development Assistance Agreement between the City and the Applicant on, or about, June 22, 2020, are attached hereto as Exhibit "B". All Agreements and documents related to Exhibits "A" and "B" remain in full force and effect unless specifically modified by this Modification/Amendment Agreement.

The Applicant has requested that the City agree to defer all payments of the 2017 and 2020 Economic Development Assistance Agreements and associated Promissory Notes for a period of six months. The request is based on the fact that the Applicant continues to recover from the economic downturn related to the COVID epidemic.

AGREEMENT:

- 1. The City and Applicant hereby agree that the Economic Development Agreements in 2017 and 2020 be modified by this Modification/Amendment Agreement to defer payments for a period of six months commencing June 1, 2024, and ending November 30, 2024.
- 2. With respect to the Economic Development Assistance Agreements in 2017 and 2020, only those portions of the Agreements related to loans will be modified to provide for a deferral of loan payments for a period of six months. Consistent with this Agreement, new payment amortization schedules for the loans will be modified to allow for a deferral of payments. New payment schedules consistent with this Modification/Amendment and Promissory Notes are attached hereto as Exhibit "C." Except for a six (6) month deferral of payments, all remaining payments, and obligations remain in full force and effect. Final payment due dates are hereby modified consistent with new payment amortization schedules attached and incorporated herein by reference. All interest is accrued according to the schedules.
- 3. Applicant agrees that all Promissory Notes shall be subject to the original Deeds of Trust executed on behalf of the Applicant in 2017 and 2020. Applicant agrees that all other terms and conditions of the original Economic Development Assistance Agreements and related documents in 2017 and 2020 for loans and all other terms and conditions shall remain in full force and effect until the loan obligations and all other obligations are fulfilled.

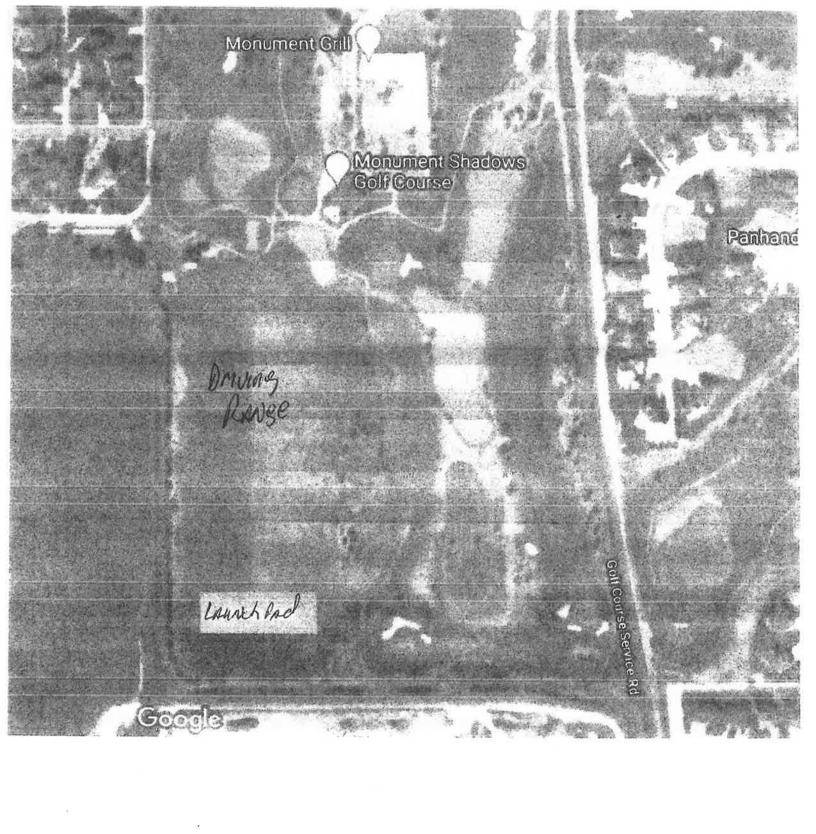
